Diagram portrays the gradual change from one hominid species to the next. The fossil record speaks for itself. This is a basic rendition and does not include other hominids that also emerged within the same time-period, such as Proconsul, Dryopithecus, Oreopithecus, Paranthropus, and Solo Man. One might also note that some lesser developed species evolved alongside or *after* the emergence of a more developed one. Cross-breeding also occurred, until modern man eventually emerged as the dominant species on the planet. (*See also Figure 11.2.)
